
Concrete Pillar Letterbox - Installation Instructions



The following instructions explain how to install your concrete pier.

DO NOT CONCRETE THE PIER LETTERBOX DIRECTLY INTO THE GROUND AS CONCRETE CAN SOMETIMES ADVERSELY REACT WITH THE RENDERED SURFACE OF THE PIER.

For some concrete piers, the front panel is stored inside the base cavity of the pier. Please check in here to retrieve the front panel.




For some products you can find the front panel inside the base cavity


OPTION 1: - LAY A CONCRETE PAVER

You will need:


- Concrete paver (approx. 45cm² square)
- · Ready mix concrete
- · Shovel
- Spirit level
- · Adhesive (e.g. Liquid Nails Landscape)




Dig a hole a about twice the depth of your paver.



Mix up some concrete with water and fill half the hole.







OPTION 2: - POUR A CONCRETE PAVER

You will need:


- · Ready mix Concrete (about 2 bags)
- Shovel
- Spirit level
- Adhesive (e.g. Liquid Nails Landscape)



Dig a hole about 7cm deep and 45 to 50cm square.




Fill the hole with freshly mixed concrete.




Wait for the concrete to fully dry before attaching the letterbox.



Apply a generous amount of adhesive such as 'Liquid Nails Landscape' to the base of the letterbox.



Place the letterbox into position.



AVOID LETTING DAMP
MATERIALS SUCH AS
MULCH, BARK OR SOIL
BUILD UP AGAINST THE
SIDE OF THE LETTERBOX,
AS IT MAY AFFECT THE
RENDER.
